- I. Program Update: Elizabeth Jernigan provided an update on Stormwater SMART staff. Joy Fields left the PTRC for a position in the mountains. The position was filled, however the new staff person was unable to meet the requirements of the position due to personal reasons. Elizabeth Jernigan will continue to manage the program until new staff can be hired. While the position is vacant, there has been no lack of programming due to Shalanda Grier, our Stormwater SMART AmeriCorps volunteer. Shalanda has done an exceptional job meeting and exceeding member needs. This is reflected in the numbers from this year. Since February, Shalanda has reached over 1,000 individuals across the region. Elizabeth recommend members confirm fair and festival participation with Shalanda.
- **II. Materials:** Elizabeth designed and order supplies and giveaways for upcoming fairs and festivals. Stormwater SMART will continue giving away grocery bags and in addition, we have erasers and stickers.
- III. Website & Social Media: Elizabeth recommended updating the Stormwater SMART website in the upcoming year to better accommodate views on mobile devices. Instead of building a website from scratch, Elizabeth recommended using WordPress or site builder applications. We also anticipate building our social media presence with the addition of a new staff person.
